History/Social Science involves making judgments about people and events. Use what you have and judge the worth of the material.		
Evaluate	Verbs: Argue, Persuade, Recommend, Criticize, Evaluate, Convince, Assess, Judge, Opinion,	<u>Level 3</u>
History/Social Science involves making sense out of a jumble of facts. Use what you have to reshape the material into a new form.		
Synthesize	Verbs: Imagine, Predict, Compose, Infer, Hypthoesize, Propose, Create, Design, Speculate	
History/Social Science involves figuring out complicated situations. Use what you have and break material down to understand it better.		
Analyze	Verbs: Compare, Contrast, Characterize, Classify, Examine, Investigate, Categorize, Question, Tell Why	<u>Level 2</u>
History/Social Science involves applying lessons of the past to the present. Use what you've learned.		
Apply	Verbs: Demonstrate, Organize, Illustrate, Construct, Map, Model, Apply Utilize, Imitate	
History/Social Science involves explaining people and events. Show that you understand what you've learned.		
Interpret	Verbs: Chart, Speculate, Summarize, Show, Explain, Describe, Restate, Translate, Report	
History/Social Science includes people, events, and dates about the past. Recall what you've learned.		<u>Level 1</u>
Recall	Verbs: Name, Define, Identify, Locate, Memorize, Label, Record, Cluster, List
